

Dear Padre

What is a L'Arche house?

A friend of mine recently volunteered to work on a "L'Arche house." She said it was for disabled people but didn't know much else. What can you tell me about it?

Dear Patrick,

L'Arche is French for "the Ark." In a L'Arche community, folks with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities come together like family to share their lives. The community began in Trosly, France, in 1964 when Jean Vanier, a Canadian Catholic layman who had been teaching at the University of Toronto, invited two men with disabilities to live with him.

From its small beginning in Trosly, L'Arche has grown into a worldwide phenomenon, with L'Arche communities in thirty-six countries. The sixteen US communities are in Iowa, Virginia, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Florida, Kansas, Alabama, Massachusetts, Washington, Oregon, New York, California, Missouri, Georgia and Washington, DC.

In 1997 Pope John Paul II gave Jean Vanier the International Paul VI Award for his work with L'Arche.

The size and shape of L'Arche communities vary from region to region, but a constant is the community's commitment to mutual respect and love. The L'Arche philosophy is that persons with disabilities possess "inherent qualities of welcome, wonderment, spirituality and friendship," and that these qualities make people with disabilities great "teachers about what is most important in life: to love and be loved."
