

Dear Padre

Can Catholics who commit suicide be buried in Catholic cemeteries?

My friend's son committed suicide. He was distraught over his brother's death and not in his right mind. Can he be buried in a Catholic cemetery?

Dear Janice,

Before I answer your question, I offer my heartfelt sympathy to your friend over the loss of his sons.

The Church teaches that our lives are "not ours to dispose of" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2280*). Suicide is a serious matter, but the Church also says that "Grave psychological disturbances, anguish, or grave fear of hardship, suffering, or torture can diminish the responsibility of the one committing suicide: (2282). Bearing that in mind, the Church compassionately states, "We should not despair of the eternal salvation of persons who have taken their own lives...God can provide the opportunity for salutary repentance. The Church prays for persons who have taken their own lives" (2283).

In general, Catholics who commit suicide are neither deprived of full burial rites in the Church, which commends all of the dead "to God's merciful love and pleads for the forgiveness of their sins" (Order of Christian Funerals, 6), nor are they deprived of burial in a Catholic cemetery - a sacred place that helps bring peace to those confronted by the suddenness of suicide.
