Do confessed sins affect priest/penitent relationships?

How does a priest keep the confession of a grievous sin by someone he knows from affecting his relationship with that person?

One of a priest's most secred responsibilities is the confidentiality of the confessional. This confidentiality encompasses everyone, even the priest and pentient outside the confessional. A priest is not allowed to discuss the confessional with the person outside the confessional unless permission is granted for further counseling.

The confessor is also furbidden to use any knowledge gained through the sacrament of reconciliation to restrict the position. For instance, if a pastor's brookkeeper confessed he was embesteding money, the pastor could not use the knowledge acquired in the confessional to fire the person.

Priests generally try to forget the specific sine parishionors confess to us, and it really isn't that difficult. Centrary to what many think, a parishioner's sine do not rush into my mind when I speak to birn or het.

We have all sinued, done things we are aslumed of, things we wouldn't want anyone to know about, things we would not want others to define us by. This knowledge and the grace of the secrement help us look past the mistakes of others and recognize Christ within them.


